## Wallace stars in late show

England's Matt Wallace rolls in a birdie putt with one of the last shots of the day at St Andrews to deny Marcus Fraser the outright lead of the Championship – but the chasing pack contains some of the game's big beasts

Australia's Marcus Fraser had clung on to the first round lead of the Alfred Dunhill Links Championship for several hours when England's Matt Wallace caught him with almost the last shot of the day.

Fraser had scored an impressive 68 at a very windy Carnoustie and had sat back and watched as many of the top names in world golf had failed to match him.

But Wallace, playing at St Andrews, sank a birdie putt on the famous 18th hole of the Old Course to share the lead.

Wallace has had a highly successful year, winning the Hero Indian Open, the BMW International Open and the Made in Denmark event, as well as finishing tied 19th in the US PGA Championship, his first Major, which included a hole-in-one.

After taking that early lead, 40-year-old Fraser said: "The more you play this tournament the more you fall in love with it.

"It's an amazing event - I just love playing in it every year."

In a congested leader board there are 22 players within three shots of

Fraser and Wallace, including some of the big beasts of world golf.

Ireland's two-time winner Padraig Harrington is one shot back, US Open and US PGA champion Brooks Koepka and England's Tyrrell Hatton, who is going for a third straight victory, are two behind, while many people's favourite Tommy Fleetwood is a further shot back. All were playing at Kingsbarns yesterday.

Hatton said: "It was a tough day. I'm glad to finish under par. I'm hoping Carnoustie will not be so windy."

# Five-star reviews behind Kuchar's Dunhill debut

After years of hearing friends rave about the tournament, the American took the short hop from Paris to Scotland

Matt Kuchar was attracted to the Alfred Dunhill Links Championship after hearing friends and fellow professionals rave about the special atmosphere surrounding this unique tournament.

The 40-year-old American is making his debut this week and was eager to make the trip to Scotland after fulfilling a vice-captain's role for the US Ryder Cup Team in Paris last week.

"I've always heard that Dunhill is great fun and I have a good buddy, Ric Kayne, who has asked me to play for a couple of years," said Kuchar, who shot a first round 73 at Kingsbarns, while the pair were on -5 in the Team Championship.

"It worked out with the Ryder Cup being in Paris that it was just an easy jump over here. I've watched it

on TV and all the people I talk to just rave about what a great event it is. I've had it on my list of tournaments to play for a while."

Kuchar suffered disappointment in Paris as the US Ryder Cup team lost to the Europeans, but he admitted that the occasion sharpened his appetite to get back to top form.

"I had a great time being involved with the Ryder Cup, but it was hard not to play, so it's nice to get back into it this week," said the American, whose best Major Championship finish was as runner-up to Jordan Spieth at Royal Birkdale last year.

"My game is a little bit rusty as I've been off for a while, but I'm glad to be playing again.

"These are beautiful courses – it's my first time playing Kingsbarns and I'm really impressed."







# Kingsbarns wind can't blow Hatton off course in hunt for hat-trick

Ryder Cup star has former Ballon d'Or winner Gullit for company as he ends first round two shots off the lead

Tyrrell Hatton's bid for an historic hat-trick of Alfred Dunhill Links Championship wins began with a 2-under-par 70 at Kingsbarns which leaves him two behind the leaders.

Wind was a big factor yesterday and nowhere were the competitors more exposed than along the coastline at Kingsbarns. Given the conditions, the champion of 2017 and 2016 was happy to end the day under par and in sight of the lead.

"Tough conditions out here," he said. "I feel like I played okay – I hit a few poor shots, which was easy to do today, but I gave myself plenty of opportunity and it was nice to hole a couple."

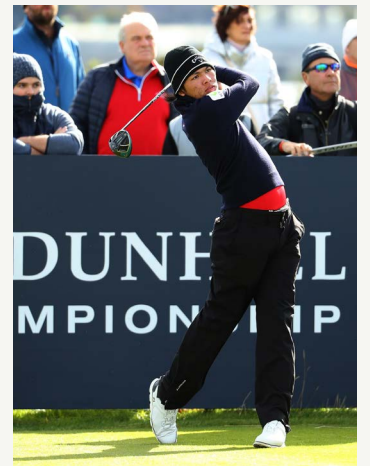
Partnering Hatton on his bid for three-in-a-row is Ruud Gullit, the former Holland, Milan and Chelsea footballer who won the Ballon d'Or for the world's best player in 1987.

Gullit said that although he loves golf and plays off a six handicap in this event, there was never a chance of him taking a different sporting path earlier in his life.

He said: "I could never have been a pro golfer because I've loved being involved in team sport, but in this event you can always contribute as an amateur partner if you play a hole well. In fact, in this format, as an amateur you don't have to play well all the time to be able to help to build a good team score!"

"But, although I was always comfortable in football, whatever the occasion, it is not always so in golf – standing on the first tee, for instance, and especially when your name is called out by the starter, is never an easy moment!"

Gullit and Hatton ended on 4-under in the Team Championship.



## Thai star's eagle is shot of the day

Thai pro Pachara Khongwatmai took the lead in the early stages of the first round with the shot of the day. He sank his wedge shot from 132-yards for an eagle two on the 453-yard, 2nd hole on the Old Course.

It took him to four-under-par, however he later dropped a shot and finished the round with a 69 in a five-way tie for second place with Padraig Harrington, Paul McGinley, Jinho Choi and Matthias Schwab.

California businessman Frank Quattrone, who specialises in mergers and acquisitions, showed at Kingsbarns that he knew a thing or two about fairways and greens as well.

He and Swedish professional Marcus Kinhult took the first round lead in the Team Championship with a nine-under-par 63. Quattrone made the cut in 2016 with Adrian Otaegui.

Scottish professional Sam Locke had only played one competitive round at Kingsbarns before shooting an opening 73, but was pleased with his effort.

"I played OK because it was a tough day in the wind, but I didn't hole many putts," said Locke, 20, the winner of the Silver Medal at the Open Championship at Carnoustie and also the 2017 Scottish Amateur champion.

There were two birdies in his round, but also three bogeys and Locke will hope to go lower when he plays Carnoustie – a course he knows particularly well – and the Old Course.

"Putting was hard and I didn't take full advantage of some of the good shots I played," added Locke, who is playing in just his second European Tour event.





# That's how you do it, boss!

Ricky Elliott, partnering three-times Major winner Brooks Koepka this week rather than caddying for him, said playing in the Alfred Dunhill Links Championship was "a dream come true" after a four-under par team score of 68 in their opening round at Kingsbarns.

Northern Irishman Elliott said: "That was brilliant, it's tremendous of Dunhill to let me play this week as Brooks' partner – and great of him to want to give me a treat like this.

"I get to play very little these days so I'd probably be a ten handicap. I'm off scratch here though and that makes it very difficult for me to beat Brooks' score. But I did come in on a couple of holes, which was nice!

"Seeing one of the world's best players from a different angle to when I'm caddying for him was also interesting – and if he plays at Kingsbarns again and gets in some of the

spots I was in, which I wouldn't expect him to, then I'll be able to offer him some extra advice!"

Koepka and Elliott finished six shots ahead of the other half of their four-ball, Brooks' brother Chase and his amateur partner Scott Mahoney. Chase is a 24-year-old pro on his first full season on the European Tour.

"We don't play together when we're at home," said Brooks. "We're on two different schedules and we're never really home at the same time.

"I enjoy watching him play, I'm trying to cheer him on as much as I can."







## A moment Fisher will never forget

2017 runner-up was 'in the zone' for record round at the Old Course

To hold the record for the Old Course in a sport where history means so much is a unique achievement and something that still delights Ross Fisher.

His breathtaking 61 in the final round of the 2017 Alfred Dunhill Links is a moment that will never be forgotten by those who witnessed it.

He recalls: "That Sunday, nothing was affecting me. I was so calm and relaxed. I've only experienced something like it a few times in my career. 61 is great when you can shoot it, but when you can shoot it around the Old Course, one of the most iconic golf courses in the world and to have a piece of history, it's pretty special."

Fisher was some way off repeating that yesterday when he shot a 75 in the first round at Kingsbarns and now moves on to Carnoustie.

He said: "The scores I've shot recently haven't reflected how I've hit the ball and how I've played. But I still feel confident in my game. I was tied second two years ago, and was second last year, it would be nice to continue that trend. Getting back into the winners' circle would be fantastic."

"I love the format. I feel relaxed. I love the fact you get to play with different people. You see celebs up there and you see normal golfers. Three courses makes it more interesting but it makes it tough and it does bring into it the luck of the draw."

# Goode gets swing tips from watching pros

Star of Downton and The Crown reveals the benefits of getting up close to the giants of golf in all conditions

Actor Matthew Goode said he marvels at the way the top professionals control their ball and swing in windy conditions, but thinks he knows their secret.

"It's tempo," said the Englishman who played Anthony Armstrong-Jones, Princess Margaret's husband, in the acclaimed TV series The Crown.

"They keep their tempo the same, even in a strong breeze, and I really notice the way that helps them.

"When you're standing next to these top players on the range, let alone out there on the course, it's incredible to watch them up close. That's always a big highlight of this week for me."

Matthew is teamed with 29-year-old South African Dean Burmester and they finished their first round at St Andrews on level par.

The Downton Abbey star, who is playing off a handicap of five, says he is enjoying his golf at the moment. "I played at Carnoustie in 30mph winds in practice and it was absolutely brutal, but still great fun.

"Getting to play in this tournament for a sixth time makes me very lucky, and my best moment remains playing with Martin Kaymer, the eventual winner, in the final group during my first appearance in 2010."

The iconic 18th at the Old Course had never seen anything like it. Four all-time great cricketers, plus Piers Morgan, took part in a Hickory Club Challenge in which the banter reached Ashes proportions.

Kevin Pietersen, Shane Warne, Michael Vaughan and Allan Lamb were joined by broadcaster Morgan to take on the famous closing hole with clubs from the 1920s and 30s.

"Please tell me you've got that on film!" cried Warne to a film crew as Morgan all but missed with a niblick. Pietersen, who had followed a booming drive with a brassie, then threw himself onto the turf as Lamb's shot headed straight for him.

"You're not chirping now, are you?" cried Morgan after lofting an approach to within 20 feet. Vaughan nailed a drive with his 'spoon' before announcing: "It's got a lovely middle!"

After a hickory putter challenge won by Pietersen, Warne admired his club. "I could use this in the tournament," he said.

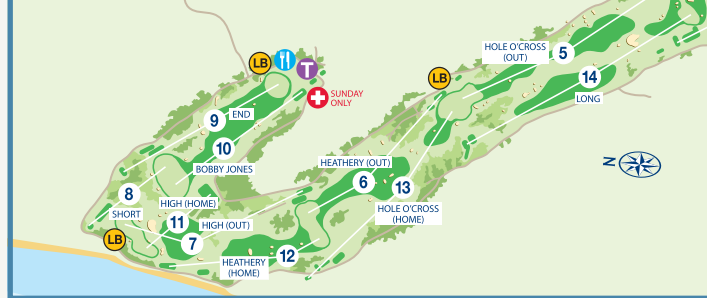

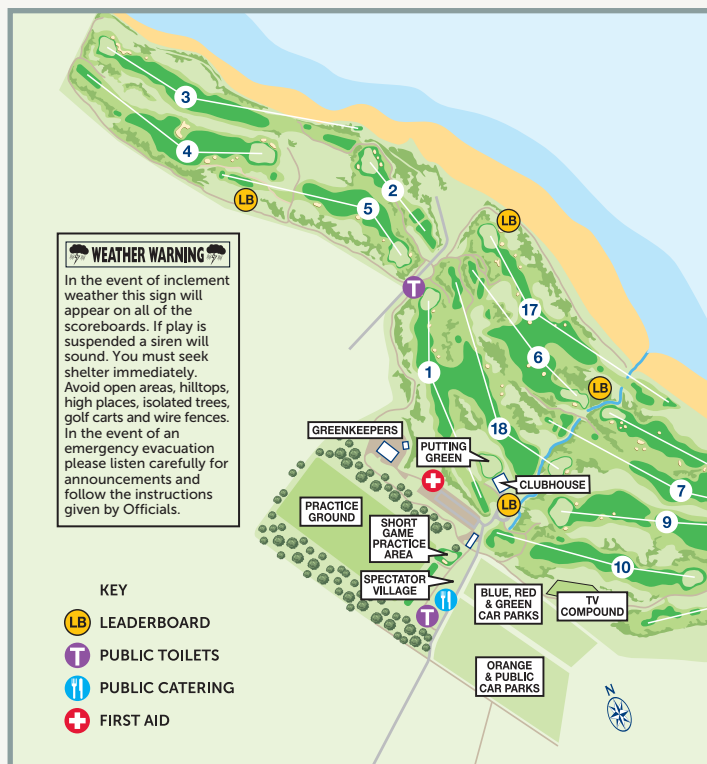

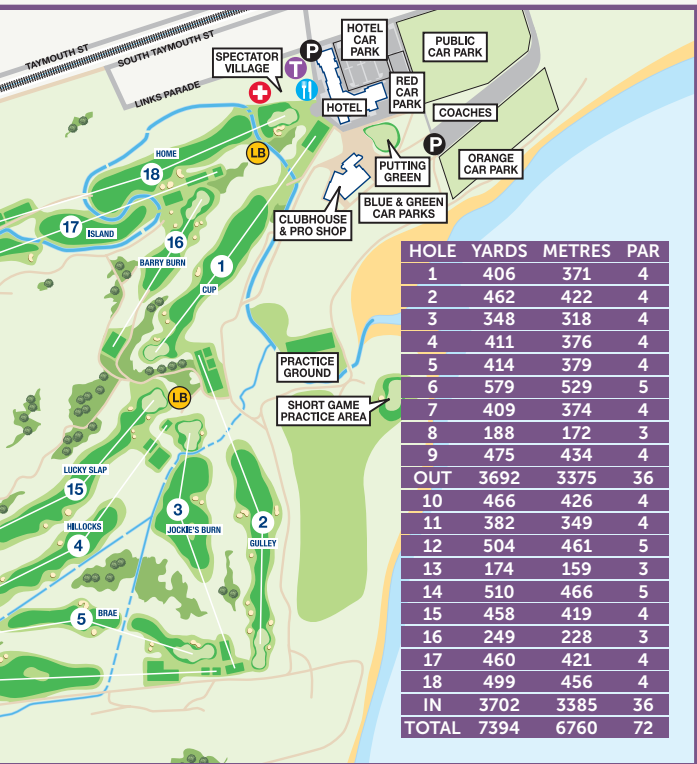


## Carnoustie
